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#### The Gymnasium at IGNOU Regional Centre Campus, Cochin

The age old adage 'Health is Wealth' is especially true in this current fast paced life. A Healthy mind and body are essential ingredients for the overall happiness of an individual to perform both personally and professionally. Now-a-days, people hardly get time to exercise. Hence, going to a Gymnasium to do exercise makes them physically and mentally active. Considering this aspect and to improve upon the health status of its staff, the Regional Centre Campus of Cochin houses a Gymnasium in the Main Building on the Ground floor.

The Gymnasium was established in the ground floor of the old block under guidance and leadership Dr. V. Venugopal Reddy, Former Regional Director (who served RC Cochin from 01/08/2011 to 02/11/2012). The staff welfare Cell and cultural club of Cochin Regional Centre manages the utilization and maintenance of the equipment in the Gym. The equipments available here are Treadmill (which is a device used for exercise consisting of a continuous moving belt on which one walks or runs); Orbitrack Exercise bike (which reduces the stress and strain on the legs through an elliptical motion); Dumbbells (which is used for joint-isolation exercises such as biceps curls, chest flyes or shoulder raises.); Barbell (which is the longer version of the dumbbell and is used for free weight training and competitive sports, such as powerlifting); Push up stand(which is used for doing push-ups, the most common form of exercise that makes use of the body weight as resistance to build muscle strength); and Hip twister(which targets to reduce the excess fat around the stomach to help to lose some extra weight).

The staff at RC Cochin makes use of this Gymnasium in their leisure time. The Gymnasium is also an attraction for little children of staff members who come to attend cultural functions and other events at the Regional Centre.

# Homage to Dr. V. Vasudevan, Former RD (1945-2019)





Dr. V. Vasudevan, former Regional Director of Regional Centre, Cochin passed away on 25.03.2019. He is survived by his wife Smt. C.K. Karthiyayini and son Mr. Khanudev, who are available at email khaaanu@gmail.com (Mobile: 7829784271).

Dr. V. Vasudevan, born on 19.02.1945, former Regional Director (Sr. Scale) of Regional Centre Cochin was transferred from Regional Service Division, Delhi (after joining services on 17.07.1989) in the year 1989 and joined Cochin Regional Centre as Additional Regional Director on 06.11.1989. He also acted as Coordinator for Lakshadweep Study Centre till a full time Coordinator assumed charge. At that time Dr. C. N. Sathyapalan was the Regional Director at Cochin Regional Centre.


Dr. V. Vasudevan had joined IGNOU on 17th July, 1989 and retired from the services of IGNOU on 28th February 2007 as Regional Director (Sr. Scale). Dr. V. Vasudevan has the distinction of being the longest serving Regional Director of RC Cochin from 17<sup>th</sup> July, 1989 to 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2001; and 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2004 to 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2007. In the interim period Dr. V. Vasudevan was the Regional Director of Hyderabad Regional Centre. During his tenure as Regional Director, RC Cochin Dr. V. Vasudevan was instrumental in acquiring land in a centrally located place of Cochin at Kaloor wherein the Regional Centre Building of Cochin presently stands. It was due to the relentless and tiring efforts of Dr. V. Vasudevan that the old Block of the Regional Centre Building could be constructed.

Dr. V. Vasudevan started his career in Kerala State Government in 1971 on completion of Masters Degree in Political Science from Kerala University. Later, Dr. V. Vasudevan joined the service of Cochin University and continued till his appointment as Probationary Officer in Indian Bank, in 1976. In the meantime, Dr. V. Vasudevan has completed the three years LLB Degree course from Kerala University. During the six years of his career in the Bank, he held many responsible positions including that as Bank Manager for nearly three years. Dr. V. Vasudevan has completed PhD Degree from MG University and Diploma in Business Administration from Indian Institute of Management, New Delhi. Dr. V. Vasudevan has also undergone PRIME Training Course and Bank Officers Training Courses.

Dr. V. Vasudevan, relinquished the service of bank in 1982, to take up the new appointment as Deputy Registrar in Cochin University of Science & Technology (CUSAT). Subsequently, Dr. V. Vasudevan was elevated to Planning and Development officer in 1988 and held the same position at CUSAT until Dr. V. Vasudevan joined IGNOU in 1989 as Regional Director, Regional Service Division Delhi.

Even after retirement, Dr. V. Vasudevan has graced the Regional Centre through his wisdom and knowledge on various important Occasions and Events. His participation in the Cultural events with family is also being remembered by all staff of Regional Centre Cochin. His presence would duly be missed by one and all at the Regional Centre Cochin.

#### Homage to Shri. K.M.Mani (1933 - 2019)



Shri. K.M. Mani, born on 30<sup>th</sup> January, 1933 was a veteran Kerala Congress leader who holds the distinction of being the longest serving Minister in the Govt. of Kerala and for having continuously represented Pala Legislative Constitution since its inception in 1964 until his death in 2019. During his stint as Honorable Former Finance Minister in 2015, Shri. K.M. Mani was instrumental in clearing the file pertaining to renewal of the lease of land to Regional

Centre, Cochin. Being the Finance Minister at that time Shri. K.M. Mani played a pivotal role in renwal/extension leasing of land to RC Cochin at a nominal rate. He has also graced on few occasions the Inaugural and Training sessions pertaining to programmes under Regional Centre, Cochin. His contributions towards the progress of Regional Centre, Cochin is duly acknowledged by one and all will be remembered forever

#### **Study Centre Corner**

In 1813, Maharani Gouri Lakshmi Bai (1810-15) of the Travancore Royal family granted 16 acres of land, 500 rupees in cash, and timber from public forests for the construction of CMS college buildings on the banks of the Meenachil river. The construction was also supported financially by the proceeds from a deposit made by Col. Coin Macaulay, the first Resident of Travancore. Founded in 1817, the CMS College is one of the top colleges in Kerala. With its 21 Departments, the CMS College offers programmes in almost all Academic fields in Arts and Sciences.

Under the leadership of Shri. Abraham Samuel, Coordinator, IGNOU Study Centre SC1406 is functioning from the campus of CMS College, Kottayam. It is a Regular Study Centre established under Regional Centre Cochin in the year 1990 with 102 students and has presently grown to 2247 IGNOU students on rolls as on January, 2019. There are around 37 IGNOU programmes activated at this Study centre which include various Post Graduate, Graduate, Diploma and Certificate programmes.
