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Face-to-Face Resumption of Office after Second Lockdown



The second wave of the COVID-19 Pandemic situation again put forth various challenges for all and the Higher Education sector was no exception. The Second Lockdown period due to COVID-19 Pandemic began in the month of April, 2021 and has in a way unleashed various unexplored avenues for rendering Student Support Services with the use of ICT enabled innovative measures and Regional Centre, Cochin has again been in forefront with its innovative initiatives and strategies.

As per Govt. of Kerala Order G.O (Rt) No.647/2021/DMD dated 15.06.2021, it was notified that all public offices would be functioning with up to 25% staff on rotation basis and remaining staff will be on work from Home. Accordingly, IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin Office resumed working in face-to-face mode with 25 percent staff capacity with effect from 17.06.2021. The face-to-face mode with full staff capacity was subsequently resumed with effect from 01.07.2021. The present Newsletter intends to cover the various Virtual/Online/Face-to-face initiatives which were undertaken during this period. Homage to Late Dr. V.V. Reddy, Former Regional Director, RC Cochin during the period from 01.08.2011 to 02.11.2012 is also done with deepest condolence to the kith and kin.

34th Convocation

The 34th Convocation is first to two events in the Universitythe first convocation being held virtually collectively for all Regional Centres after the University has been accredited with NAAC A++ grade. The University awarded 2,37,844 Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates of different programmes to the successful students at 34th convocation on 15.04.2021. The Convocation function was held virtually from the Baba Saheb Ambedkar Convention Centre, IGNOU Headquarter in COVID-19 light of the surge in cases. The Convocation ceremony was streamed live on 'You Tube' and Swayam Prabha Channels for Higher Education Managed by IGNOU in addition to Gyan Darshan, Channel of the University, the 56 Regional Centers and the learners across the country.

Sh. Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank', Hon'ble Minister of Education, Govt. of India delivered the Convocation Address through virtual mode.

Congratulating the successful students Sh. Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank', Hon'ble Minister of Education, Govt. of India lauded the role played by IGNOU since its inception in making quality higher education accessible to all through the affordable Open and Distance Mode. The Hon'ble Minister in his speech stressed on the need to provide education that could make one self-reliant is the key-highlight of the New Education Policy that integrates vocational education bringing constructive changes in the education system. In order to achieve the goal of 50% GER (Gross Enrolment Ratio) by 2035, the University will have to be a crucial contributor, he added. Highlighting the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) which is a key part of the New Education Policy, 2020, the Hon'ble Minister said that it provides learners with the flexibility to choose his bouquet of courses and also letting him/her to complete it even after a gap. He urged the University to

revamp the existing Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes while working on the new programmes according to the needs of the country which not only provide education but also employment to accrue the demographic dividend. On the occasion, he congratulated the University for getting NAAC A++ grade. The Hon'ble Minister also congratulated the meritorious students for their performance.

Twenty Nine (29) Medals were awarded to the meritorious students at the ceremony virtually. Degree certificates were also conferred to the successful students in different streams for 55 PhD and 13 M.Phil degree recipients at the convocation. This time female students have excelled and out of total 29 medals, 21 were awarded to female students and of the total PhD and M.Phil degrees awarded, 37 were to female students.

Prof. Nageshwar Rao, Vice-Chancellor of the University in his welcome address presented and apprised the Hon'ble Minister and Audience (virtually across the dispersed locations) of the last year report summing up the activities undertaken by the university in the trying times of COVID-19 pandemic. He informed that the university through its network of 56 Regional Centers and 21 schools provided non-stop academic support to learners through Digital technology. He highlighted that apart from the online sessions held by the Regional Centers during the pandemic more than 300 sessions were conducted by IGNOU faculty through the Facebook platform of the university. He reiterated the vision and mission of the university to provide affordable, accessible quality higher education to all sections of society irrespective of their backgrounds increasing the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER).

As per the Standard Operating Procedure , adherence for Social Distancing, wearing of masks and frequent washing of hands were followed in view of the second wave of the COVID-19 pandemic at the Convocation Venue while keeping the gathering to witness the 34th Convocation.

During the convocation, 4139 learners from Regional Centre, Cochin of have successfully completed their Academic programmes in this convocation. Around 2274 learners collected their Degrees and Diplomas Certificates.

Induction Meeting (January 2021)

A Live Facebook Online/Virtual Induction Meeting hosted by IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin for students of January, 2021 session was conducted through Google Meet platform on O1st June, 2021 from 11.30 pm to 3.00 pm and the session was live streamed through the Official Facebook page of IGNOU. The Coordinators/staff of various LSC along with the staff of Regional Centre, Cochin attended the meeting and the meeting was live streamed on the Facebook page of IGNOU on 01.06.2021.The Live streamed Induction Meeting video was then uploaded on the RC Cochin Facebook page and RC Cochin YouTube channel and has received 5.8k views as on 30th June, 2021.

Dr. J.S. Dorothy, Regional Director, RC Cochin welcomed all the participants and addressed the learners on how to study with IGNOU. The importance of Self check questions and use of study materials online was highlighted along with the importance of life skills for a Distance Learner. It was emphasized that Honesty, Taking one day at a time, Persistence, Expression of Interest, Stead fastness and Peer Interaction are very important life skills for a Distance Learner to enable him/her cope up with the Professional, Social and Educational responsibilities.

Ms. Sujini Babu, Assistant, Regional Centre, Cochin then explained about the significance of Enrolment Number, the difference between Fresh Admission and Re-registration, Minimum and Maximum period of Study made available at IGNOU.

Dr. L. Chandra Sekaran, PS then elaborated on the facilities available at Regional Centre, Cochin for the Learners in which the facilities available for students including the location, timings, accessibility to Regional centre was highlighted. The IGNOU website and Regional Centre, Cochin website was elaborated upon so that learners can avail of the support services by visiting the website on a regular basis.

After this, Dr. Sindhu P. Nair, DD explained about the importance of Study Materials, its structure and how it can be downloaded from the IGNOU website; pre-requisites of Scholarship for special clientele and the procedure to apply; Facilities available at the Learner Support Centres.

In the next presentation, Dr. V.T. Jalajakumari, ARD explained about Online Counseling session to the learners in which it was mentioned that Online/Virtual platform would be used to enhance the reachability, to facilitate learning without moving from one place to the other. The process of intimation of the schedule to Learners by uploading in the Regional centre website and intimation through SMS/email was highlighted. The Learner etiquette needed was also informed to learners. Dr. Jalajakumari also explained about the Internal Assessment at IGNOU specifically emphasizing on modalities of writing and submitting Assignment Response. The online method of downloading of Assignment questions and uploading of Assignment Response was also explained.

Dr. S. Vijayaragavan, Asst. Regional Director, Regional Centre, Cochin explained about Examination and Convocation to the students in which online submission of Examination form was highlighted. The Convocation being held once in a year was also informed to the Learners.

The Coordinators of various LSCs like Dr. A.K. Prema, SC14000, Dr. Tom Varghese, SC1402 and Dr. Aishwarya S. Babu, SC1407 also shared their inputs for

Learners in the Induction meeting wherein the important points to be kept in mind by learners was highlighted again.

Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan, Asst. Director, Regional Centre, Cochin finally summarized the session by covering the main points as a Checklist starting from downloading of ID card to receiving of Certificate from IGNOU, so as to enable the Learners to successfully complete their programme from IGNOU.

The Online/Virtual Live session for students of January, 2021 learners was well received by one and all. The programme was coordinated/administered by Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan AD and technical assistance for the same was provided by Shri. Muhammad Ansar, AEDP.





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
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
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




Screenshot of Presentation presented by Dr. Sindhu P. Nair, DD during the Facebook Live Promotional Meeting on 28.06.2021



Homage to Dr. V. Venugopal Reddy (1957-2021; RD Cochin from 01.08.2011 to 02.11.2012)



Dr. V. Venugopal Reddy born on 01.04.1957 was a renowned Educationalist and Administrator of IGNOU and superannuated from the services of IGNOU in 2019. Dr. Reddy began his career as Assistant Professor in the Department of Commerce, School of Management Studies of IGNOU, New Delhi in February, 1987 and later shifted to Student Support services in 1989. Dr. Reddy worked in different capacities as Assistant Director, Deputy Director and Regional Director in Regional Centres such as Bangalore, Cochin, Delhi-I, Delhi-2, Jammu and Vijayawada and served as the first Director, Research Unit IGNOU, New Delhi between 2009 and 2011 and as Regional Director (Sr. Scale) in Regional Services Division (Hqs). Dr. Reddy superannuated from the services of IGNOU in the year 2019 as Senior Regional Director, Regional Centre Bangalore.

IGNOU Regional Centre Cochin deeply condoles the sad demise of Dr. Reddy on 12.06.2021. His contributions towards the progress of Regional Centre Cochin is duly acknowledged by one and all and will be remembered forever.

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
