
As a part of implementation of the recommendations of NEP 2020, the University is conducting LIVE Online Academic Counseling sessions in thirteen Regional Languages. The thirteen Regional Languages are Assamese, Bengali, English, Gujarati, Hindi, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu and Urudu. The sessions are being broadcast through Channel 19 in Malayalam language from 3.50 to 4.50 pm on working days.

IGNOU Regional Centre Cochin has been designated as the Nodal Office for conduct of LIVE Channel Based Counseling Session in Malayalam Language for the Programmes under CBCS (Choice Based Credit System). Thirty Six Live counseling sessions have been conducted by IGNOU Regional Centre Cochin from January 2022 to March 2022. Dr. J S Dorothy, Regional Director, IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin, gave an Overview about the






### **Exam Centre Superintendents' Meeting**







# **Study Centre Corner**

Central Prison, Viyyur (LSC 14168D)



As per https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Central\_Prison, Viyyur, "the H.H. Parukutty Nethyaramma Consort Queen of Kochi and Wife of Maharaja Rama Varma donated the family property to establish the new prison at Viyyur. After independence, the Government of Kerala, took over the facility and converted to a Central Prison intended to detain long term prisoners".

The architecture of Central Prison is unique in that the arial view will appear in circles indicating flower petals with the mid point being clock tower. As per https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Central\_Prison,\_Viyyu r, "The Central Jail is located in the center of the entire prison property, separated from the rest of the area via a circular perimeter wall almost 6 metres

(20 ft) high, with a central watch tower at its center. There are six blocks for confining prisoners situated as the petals of a flower pointing towards the office block. Besides the prisoners blocks, there are separate buildings such as the kitchen, stores, manufactory section, library, hospital ward, prayer hall (consists of temple, church and mosque) and outside the prison the barrack hall, staff mess, staff canteen and cattle sheds etc. are situated".

The IGNOU Special Study Center was established in 2013 in the Library block. The main aim for establishing IGNOU Special Study centre was to give wings to the dreams for higher education amidst the jail inmates. With 27 students in 2013, the Centre has

grown to be a Centre of education including women jail inmates also. The Welfare Officer Sh. TG Santhosh was the first coordinator of the 14168D Special Study Centre. Sh. Thomas O.J., has taken over as Coordinator from the year 2017. There are presently three programmes on offer at Certificate level namely CAL CFN and CFE. Educational Tourism of the prison inmates to various pilgrimage places was also undertaken by providing food and shelter arrangement besides a small pocket money given to be spent at will. It was learnt that most of the prisoners returned the pocket money unspent back to the prison official.
