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Help Desk during Conduct of Face-to-Face Examination after second lockdown




A Help desk was made operational at Regional centre, Cochin during June TEE, 2021 to facilitate differentlyabled/socially excluded group learners to write the examinations smoothly in the Study centre 14000. One of the Help desk Officials was deputed to stand near the thermal checking and facilitate prioritizing in extending services to Special Need Learner and quarantined learners. The Help Desk team also ensured that there was no student unrest, the examination seats were sanitized before and after examination and seating arrangement of the Examination Centre under LSC14000 (Study Centre in Regional Centre Campus) was as per the COVID-19 protocol to ensure cleanliness of the premises and examination hall.

The conduct of Face-to-Face Examination after the second lockdown period was one of the major challenges faced by RC Cochin. The Term End Examination June 2021 was conducted from 3rd August 2021 to 9th September 2021 as per COVID protocol with support from Exam Centre Superintendents/Coordinators/Exam Centre Staff of all Examination Centres. The Examinations were conducted at 14 Examination Centres under the region at Ernakulam, Kottayam, Idukki, Thrissur and Union Territory of Lakshadweep with 44538 registered examinees. The Examinations were conducted smoothly in all Districts under the jurisdiction Regional Centre Cochin. The Study Centre SC 14000 functioning from Regional Centre Campus also served as the Examination Centre.


Sh. K.J. Joseph, SO and Sh. K. Muraleedharan, SO coordinated the event by rendering administrative support.










Screenshot of Presentation presented by Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan, AD during the Face book Live Promotional Meeting on 05.07.2021




Screenshot of Presentation presented by Dr. Sindhu P. Nair, DD during the Face book Live Promotional Meeting on 06.07.2021
