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

Facebook Live Induction Meeting through Official Facebook page of IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin


A Live Facebook Online/Virtual Induction Meeting hosted by IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin was conducted through Google Meet platform on 28th January, 2021 from 11.30 am to 2.00 pm and the session was live streamed through the Official Facebook page of IGNOU. Around 100 participants attended the meeting and has received about 5.5k views in Facebook page of IGNOU as on 06.02.2021. The meeting was administered and coordinated by Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan, AD and technical assistance for the same was provided by Shri. Muhammad Ansar T.A., AEDP.

Dr. J.S. Dorothy, Regional Director welcomed all the participants and invited Dr. Hema Pant, Deputy Director, RSD, IGNOU Head Quarters, Delhi for the meeting. Chandra Sekaran, PS then elaborated on the facilities available at Regional Centre, Cochin for the Learners in which the facilities available for students through the IGNOU website and Regional Centre, Cochin website was elaborated.

Induction Meeting through Webex platform





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


Participants during the Online/Virtual induction Meeting on 30.01.2021

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
Exam Centre Superintendents Meeting





There were 66698 students registered for the examinations.

Online Counseling



Screenshot of the Virtual/Online Open Session cum Enrichment Session on 19.01.2021





John Paul Memorial College is the result of the dream of a group of fathers of the St. Joseph's Province of CST Fathers Aluva, to provide education to the economically and culturally less advantaged people of the High Ranges. In 2005 upon the request of neighbouring parents, priests in the ashram arranged tuition programme in front of the

Little Flower Ashram Chapel. Later the demands of the people lead them to start a private open regular junior college which later metamorphosed in the forms of Private Degree College in Idukki District and later to the functioning of UG and PG courses affiliated to MG University, Kottayam in 2008.




Entrance of JPM Arts and Science College, Kattappana

IPM Educational Institutions consists of John Paul Memorial B. Ed College, JPM Arts and Science College and JPM Junior College overlooking to the busy Kattappana-Kuttikkanam stretch of the Kattappana-Kottayam state highway in Idukki District. The college has been maintaining excellent results since its inception. At the time of announcement of university results, JPM is one of the top scorer in Idukki district. To enhance the quality of students the college periodically conducts national seminars, add-on-courses, department wise intercollegiate fests, industrial visits, training programmes etc. This College is located only 5.6 kilometres away from Kozhimala tribal settlement which is the only existing tribal kingdom in South India that falls under the Kanchiyar Grama Panchayath of Idukki tehsil. JPM College is an easy access to the culturally and economically disadvantaged sections of that community and the students from the community pursue their degree studies at JPM. The College also conducts many of its extension activities in connection with the Mannan community of Kovilmala.

The College is keen in maintenance of high discipline among the students which will go a long way in fine tuning their potential. The College also provides excellent lab and library facilities for its students including the subscription of various magazines, national and international journals, Civil Service, UPSC,SSC competition materials etc.

JPM Arts and Science College was granted the Minority Status by Central Government of India on 28/06/2013 and was given the number 1230/2013/7078 in their official

records. In connection with the decennial celebration of the college (2005-2015) JPM Career Academy- coaching Centre for competitive examinations was started on October 2015. In the same year College had become the first ISO - 9001:2008 certified college in Idukki district. In 2016 JPM had become a registered trademark.
