# IGNOU Regional Centre Cochin on the Map of SWAYAM Portal

IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin is the first Regional Centre to be on the Map of SWAYAM Portal in the year 2018 with the launch of Certificate course in Environmental Sustainability on the SWAYAM platform of MHRD and the credit goes to the former Regional Director of Cochin Dr. M. Rajesh (presently Regional Director of Regional Centre, Vatakara). The course covered four independent modules- Environment and Society, Environmental Education and Jurisprudence, Environment Friendly Technologies and International Conventions on Environment and explored the complex inter-relationship of Environment for Academic transaction was facilitated by Dr. M. Rajesh by being the Principal Investigator. The course coordinators were Dr. M. Rajesh, Dr. Sindhu P. Nair, Asst. Regional Director, Dr. V.T. Jalajakumari, Asst. Regional Director and Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan, Asst. Director.

The first schedule of the course was run from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 as Awareness programme and subsequently re-run from 1<sup>st</sup> March to 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2019 and 1<sup>st</sup> October to 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 as Certificate programme. Around 6000 learners enrolled and have been benefitted from the course.

## **Collaboration for Vidyajwala-2019**
