


Student receiving Degree Certificate from the Guest of Honour at 35th IGNOU Convocation at Regional Centre Cochin on 26.04.2022

Induction Meeting (January 2022)

A Live Facebook Online/Virtual Induction Meeting was hosted by IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin for students of January, 2022 session and conducted through Webex platform on 13th April, 2022 from 11.00 am to 1.00 pm and the session was live streamed through the Official Facebook page of IGNOU RC Cochin. The Coordinators/staff of various LSC along with the staff of Regional Centre, Cochin attended the meeting and the meeting was live streamed on the Facebook page of IGNOU on 13.04.2022 and has received 3.3k views as on 27th April, 2022.

Dr. J.S. Dorothy, Regional Director, RC Cochin welcomed all the participants and addressed the learners on how to study with IGNOU. The importance of Self check questions and use of study materials online was highlighted along with the importance of life skills for a Distance Learner. It was emphasized that Honesty, Taking one day at a time, Persistence, Expression of Interest, Stead fastness and Peer Interaction are very important life skills for a Distance Learner to enable him/her cope up with the Professional, Social and Educational responsibilities.

Ms. Sujini Babu, Assistant, Regional Centre, Cochin then explained about the significance of Enrolment Number, the difference between Fresh Admission and Re-registration, Minimum and Maximum period of Study made available at IGNOU.

Shri. Sebastian D'Cruz, EDP then elaborated on the facilities available at Regional Centre, Cochin for the Learners in which the facilities available for students including the location, timings, accessibility to Regional centre was highlighted. The IGNOU website and Regional Centre, Cochin website was elaborated upon so that learners can avail the support services by checking the same on a regular basis.

Dr. V.T. Jalajakumari, ARD further explained about the importance of Study Materials, its structure and how one can download the same from the IGNOU website. The importance of Online Counseling session to the learners was highlighted in which it was mentioned that Online/Virtual platform would be used due to the COVID 19 pandemic situation. The process of intimation of the schedule to Learners by uploading in the Regional centre website and intimation through SMS/email was highlighted. The Learner etiquette needed was also informed to learners. Dr. V.T. Jalajakumari, ARD also explained about the Internal Assessment at IGNOU specifically emphasizing on modalities of writing and submitting assignments. The online method of downloading of Assignment questions was explained. Examination and Convocation related activities to the students were deliberated with the new provisions for online submission of Examination form since June 2020 session. The Convocation being held once in a year was also informed to the Learners.

Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan, Asst. Director, Regional Centre, Cochin explained about the pre-requisites of Scholarship for special clientele and how one can apply for the same. Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan, Asst. Director, also summarised the session by covering the main points as a Checklist starting from downloading of ID card to receiving of Certificate from IGNOU, so as to enable the Learners to successfully complete their programme from IGNOU.

The Online/Virtual Live session for students of January, 2022 learners was well received by one and all. The programme was coordinated/administered by Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan, AD and technical assistance for the same was provided by Shri. Muhammad Ansar, AEDP. Term End Examination (December 2021)

The IGNOU Term End Examination for December, 2021 was conducted from 4th March 2022 to 11th April 2022. The Examinations were conducted at 14 Examination Centres under the region at Ernakulam, Kottayam, Idukki, Thrissur and Union Territory of Lakshadweep with 76694 registered examinees. The Examinations were conducted smoothly in all Districts under Regional Centre Cochin. The Study Centre SC 14000 functioning from Regional centre Campus also served as the Examination Centre.

It is noteworthy to specify that with effect from December 2021 TEE, the three Academics Dr. V.T. Jalajakumari, ARD and Dr. S. Vijayaragavan, ARD served as Exam Centre Superintendent for the LSC14000 situated in the Regional Centre campus headed by Dr. A.K. Prema, Coordinator, 14000.




Rural Academy for Management Studies, Cochin (LSC 14157)
