India (Since 2011); Expert Member, Scientific Panel (Fish& Fish Processing), Food Safety and Standards Authority of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India (Since 2013); Member of the Senate at CUSAT three times, Faculty, Board of Studies, Faculty and Academic Council; Secretary, Senate, Academic Council and Syndicate, CUSAT from 2004 to 2008 and 2011-2013; Member, National Task Force for the development of Green Certification of ornamental fishes, Marine Products Export Development Authority, Ministry of Commerce, Government of India; Chairman, Children's Science Congress for three terms (2011, 2012 and 2013) organized by Kerala Science and Technology Society (India) and Rotary Club of Cochin Lords; Successfully completed 10 National and International Major Projects including multi institutional projects as Principal Investigator or Chief Coordinator.

Ramachandran has 247 No of papers, technical articles/reports, books and Policy Documents published; 70 Refereed publication (Journals/Int. proceedings); 35 No of International publications (Refereed); 12 No. of FAO publications (in Infofish,APFIC Symposium/Working party proceedings; 15 International -conference proceedings & others. Prof.(Dr.) A. Ramachandran, is also a Member of the Faculty of Marine Sciences for two terms and have Functioned in various Government Committees like Inspection Committees, Organising Committees of Aqua fest, etc.

Prof.(Dr.) A. Ramachandran, has a teaching experience of over 30 years out of which he had held the tenure as Dean, Faculty of Environmental Studies, Director, School of Industrial Fisheries Registrar, Controller of Examinations at Cochin University of Science and Technology, Cochin.

Balakrishnan Nair International Environmental Excellence Award in January 2019 from Hawassa University, Ethiopia.

The Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) has been a pioneer in the field of Open and Distance Learning for the past few decades. Established by an Act of Parliament in 1985, IGNOU has continuously striven to build an inclusive knowledge society through inclusive education. It has tried to increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) by offering high-quality teaching through the Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode.

Ladies and Gentlemen, I feel privileged in presenting to this august gathering, my report, giving a brief account of some major, new initiatives and

achievements of the IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin during the academic year 2019-20.

The Regional Centre, Cochin was established in the year 1988 and recall with gratitude the contribution by the founding fathers like Prof.Satyapalan, Founding Regional Director, Dr.V.Vasudevan, Former Regional Director and Dr.K.S.Divakaran Nair, Former Regional Director in whose tenure, the Regional Centre moved to the own premises and had its development of buildings large enough to house the Regional Centre, Regional Evaluation Centre and the Model Study Centre. Special efforts of the former Regional Directors Dr.M.Shanmugam, Dr. V.Venugopal Reddy, Dr.M.Rajesh and Dr.Sindhu P. Nair in sustaining the vision of the founding fathers and the mission for which the University was created in the year 1985.

The IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin was established on 17th November, 1988 to provide open and distance education in the State of Kerala and the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. Over the years, the activities of IGNOU in the region grew and a number of Study Centres were established with substantial student enrolment in various academic programmes of the University. With the establishment of Regional Centre, Trivandrum in the year 2009, jurisdiction of three southern districts of the State viz., Kollam, Pathanamthitta and Thriuvananthapuram districts have been allotted to the Regional Centre, Trivandrum. Later, in 2011, another Regional Centre was established at Vatakara in Kozhikode district, with present jurisdiction of five northern districts - Kasaragod, Kannur, Kozhikode, Wayanad and Malappuram. Now, the Regional Centre, Cochin caters to six districts of Kerala viz., Ernakulam, Thrissur, Palakkad, Kottayam, Idukki and Alappuzha. In addition, the Union Territory of Lakshadweep also comes under the jurisdiction of Regional Centre, Cochin.

The University constructed two blocks of building- a four storied building and another six storied building for the Regional Centre at Kaloor, Cochin. The four-storied Regional Centre building has the Regional Centre, the Gyan Vani FM Radio Station, Computer Labs, classrooms, conference rooms and Library. The Six-storied Regional Centre building has the Regional Evaluation Centre and the Model Study Centre.

#### 1. Teaching -Learning

The Regional Centre functions through a network of 36 Learner Support Centres (LSC) across the region. In the past year One new LSC has been established. The Regular Study Centre was established at St Michael's College, Cherthala, Allepey

(SC-14187). It is pertinent to mention that the intiative for establishment of this LSC was initiated in the tenure of Dr.M.Rajesh and Dr.Sindhu P.Nair as Regional Director. As such there are 19 Regular Study Centres, 7 Programme Study Centres, and 8 Special Study Centres under Cochin Regional Centre.

Nearly, 87 academic programmes of IGNOU are being activated under the Cochin Region with the assistance of the 34 Learner Support Centres.

At present the Regional Centre Cochin has cumulative strength of around <u>25210</u> learners for the July 2019(Fresh =10192;+ RR=6612=16804) and January 2019 (Fresh = 4857;+RR=3549=8406). For the previous two sessions vis-a-vis January 2018 and July 2018, the Regional Centre Cochin has cumulative strength of around <u>22251</u> learners for the January 2018 (Fresh =4760;+ RR=3292=8052) and July 2018(Fresh =8817;+ RR=5382=14200). As such there is an additional student strength of 2959 for the July 2018 and January 2019 when compared to the earlier two sessions resulting in 13.2% increase in enrolment.

#### 2. Orientation Programmes for Academic Counselors

A Total number of 152 Academic Counselors have been Oriented in the 5 Orientation Programmes organised between 1st Jan 2019 to 31st Dec 2019. All Four academics of the Regional Centre -Dr. Sindhu P. Nair, ARD, Dr.V.T.Jalajakumari, ARD, Dr.S.Vijayaraghavan, ARD and Dr.Praseetha Unnikrishnanan, AD served as the Resource Persons at the Orientation Programmes for Academic Counselors. The Schedule, conduct and Report of the Orientation Programmes for Academic Counselors held at IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin was undertaken by Dr.V.T.Jalajakumari, ARD

## 3. Meeting of LSC functionaries

Both Coordinators' Meeting and Part-Time Staff meeting (also referred to as Orientation Programme for LSC Functionaries) was held to trickle down the policy initiatives like online empanelment of Academic counsellors, Online payment of the remuneration/honorarium, introduction of the Choice Based Credit System, Open and Distance learning system, Tutor comments, Online entry of Awards.

The Regional Centre Cochin conducted two Coordinators' meetings on 28.02.2019 and 18.07.2019. Academic, administrative and financial matters pertaining to functioning of Learner Support Centers were deliberated during these meetings.

A Total number of 68 LSC functionaries (Part-Time Staff -Assistant Coordinators / Assistant) have been oriented in the 3 Orientation Programmes held between 1st

Jan 2019 to 31st Dec 2019. All Four academics of the Regional Centre -Dr. Sindhu P. Nair, ARD, Dr.V.T.Jalajakumari, ARD, Dr.S.Vijayaraghavan, ARD and Dr.Praseetha Unnikrishnanan, AD served as the Resource Persons at the Orientation Programmes for Academic Counselors. The Schedule, conduct and Report of the Orientation Programmes for Academic Counselors held at IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin was undertaken by Dr.V.T.Jalajakumari, ARD.

#### 4 Extension Activities

The Swachh Bharat Abhiyan initiated in 2014 was sustained in the year 2019 at Cochin Regional Centre by joining along with Regional Evaluation Centre/IGNOU Model Study Centre 14000. During this year 2019, the involvement of the Staff to sustain a clean environment in the campus was ensured.

The UBA Activities which were held at Edathala and Chendamangalam Village targeting the weaving community residing there till 2018 were expanded for reach to facilitate active participating in the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) - a flagship Programme of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, to involve Higher Education Institutions of the country for indigenous development of self-sufficient and sustainable village clusters for inclusive India. In the year 2019, IGNOU Regional Centre Cochin has received permission from the District Administration of Ernakulam, Alappuzha and Palakkad Districts to adopt six villages Aluva East, Chendamangalam, Nedumbassery, Paravoor, Arthunkal and Puducode for UBA Activities. The Regional Centre conducted three IGNOU awareness Programmes at Edathala Gram Panchayat in April, May and July of 2019. Regional Centre Cochin has also organized Plastic free campaigns at five adopted Villages Edathala, Chendamangalam, Puducode, Arthunkal and Punnapra during September - October 2019.

## 5. Contributors for the Online Programme in the SWAYAM Portal

Under the leadership of the former Regional Director Dr. M.Rajesh, Three of the academics namely Dr.Sindhu P.Nair, Dr.V.T.Jalajakumari and Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan were instrumental to launch the Certificate Programme on Environment Sustainability (First launched in 2018 as a Non-credit Programme) in the SWAYAM Portal. As such, three of the five Academics of Regional Centre Cochin are National Faculty for MOOCs of SWAYAM under MHRD.

#### 6. Collaborations Organised

The Public-Private and Public-Public Collaborations were Organised under the aegis of IGNOU Regional Centre Cochin to execute the activities of both Academic and Extension in nature. The following Collaborations were Organised in the year 2019:

- **6.1. With the Block Development Office:** The Block Development Office, Mulanthuruthy, Ernakulam collaborated with IGNOU Regional Centre Cochin to mobilize Tree Sapling for the "One Student One Tree" Programme under Plantation Drive of MHRD held at Regional Centre Cochin. The event was coordinated by Dr.V.T.Jalajakumari, ARD.
- 6.2. With the District Collectors: The District Collectors of three districts collaborated to adopt Six villages (Arthungal, Puthukode, Chendamangalam, Edathala-Aluva East, Punnapra and Nedumbassery) under UBA. Plastic free campaign held under UBA at Punnapra, Arthunkal, Puthucode, Chendamangalam and Edathala (Aluva East). The event was coordinated by all Four academics of the Regional Centre -Dr. Sindhu P. Nair, ARD, Dr.V.T.Jalajakumari, ARD, Dr.S.Vijayaraghavan, ARD and Dr.Praseetha Unnikrishnanan, AD.
- **6.3. Promotional Initiatives:** Promotional Meetings were held by IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin in the year 2019 focusing on creating awareness about IGNOU Programmes. In the year 2019, Thirty eight promotional meetings were conducted by Regional Centre Cochin focussing on various target groups like, Students of B.Ed/Under-Graduate students/ITI; Teachers/College Faculties; Police officials; Men/Women Jail Inmates; Kudumbashree workers; Resident Welfare Association; TOLIC Officials; Through AIR FM Radio.

Of the Promotional meeting held, the Awareness Programme done in non-LSC Educational Institution (Out of 38 Promotional Meetings held in 2019, 24 were at Non-LSC category) indicate collaboration with wide array of institutions to promote IGNOU Programmes. It is also pertinent to mention that the role of the Principal and Coordinator of the Host Institution housing the LSC of IGNOU enabled the conduct of the promotional meeting in the host institution at the time of their admission, through IQAC wing which not only augmented the enrolment at the LSC but also paved way for add on qualification in the learners which augment their profile while entering into the employment market. All Four academics of the Regional Centre -Dr. Sindhu P. Nair, ARD, Dr.V.T.Jalajakumari, Dr.S.Vijayaraghavan, ARD and Dr.Praseetha Unnikrishnanan, AD served as the Resource Persons at the Promotional meetings. The consolidation of the Promotional Meetinas held **IGNOU** Regional Centre. Cochin by was undertaken by Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnanan, AD.

6.4 Resource Person for Open cum Enrichment Sessions under Innovation Club held along with Grievance and Redressal session: Besides the Four Academics at the Regional Centre, the Resource Person for Open cum Enrichment Sessions under Innovation Club in the year 2019 were from the HDFC Bank, IDBI Bank, M/s Charris Food Products Ltd and O/O Head (I/c), Hindi Teaching Scheme, Cochin. Dr.A.K.Prema, Coordinator, IGNOU Study Centre (14000) and Shri. K.K.Joseph, Assistant Registrar, IGNOU Regional Centre, Cochin facilitated the mobilisation of external resource persons for the Open cum Enrichment Sessions under Innovation Club in the year 2019. The reporting of the proceedings of the Open cum Enrichment Sessions under Innovation Club held along with Grievance and Redressal session Dr. Praseetha Unnikrishnan, Nodal Officer for the Innovation Club Activity at Regional Centre Cochin.

#### 14. 'One student-One tree' Programme

The Regional Centre Cochin undertook plantation drives at various districts under the 'One student- One Tree' Programme during August 2019. Saplings were distributed as well as planted at five places - LSC 14184 Al-Ameen College Edathala; LSC 14182D Ansar Women's College Perumpilavu; LSC 14183 CHF Family Apostolate Training and Research Institute Velur; LSC 14180 VISWA Institute of Contemporary Allied Studies Punnapra and LSC 14127 Nirmala College Muvattupuzha. #### 15. Term End Examination conducted

IGNOU conducted the Term End Examination (TEE) in the months of June and December every year. The number of examination centres which were established for conduct of theory and practical examinations during June 2019 (0619) and December 2019 (1219)Term End Examination (TEE) were 12 and 14 respectively. The course-wise examinees in the region for the June 2019 and December 2019 Term End Examination (TEE) was 57,758 and 63,098 respectively. Observers for the Term End Examination (TEE) in June 2019 and in December 2019 were 20. The total number of assignment awards transmitted to IGNOU headquarters from the Cochin for the Term End Examination (TEE) of June 2019 was 43534 and December 2019 is expected to be around 35822. Keeping in view with the inclusive education of the Indian subcontinent, special assistance to the differently abled by means of the amanuensis were rendered to 11 learners each in Term End Examination (TEE) June 2019 and in December 2019.

The internship records of BBARL, MAPC and BAPC programmes evaluated for the June 2019 (0619) Term End Examination (TEE) were 134 and for the December 2019 (1219) Term End Examination (TEE) were 107.

IGNOU has moved to provide e-content of the Study material for a concession of the fee at the time of admission in the year 2019.

### 18. Online application for the Empanelment of Academic counsellors/Evaluators

IGNOU depends on the Part-Time Faculty empanelled as Academic counsellors for the Academic Transactions at the Learner Support Centres and Evaluators for evaluation of the Term End Examination Answer Scripts. In order to facilitate the empanelment of the Academic Counsellors/ Evaluators, Online application for the Empanelment of Academic counsellors/ Evaluators has been initiated in the year 2018 to link the various approving authority at the Learner Support Centre, Regional centre, Head Quarters.

This  $33^{\rm rd}$  Convocation at Cochin is both for the Regional Centre Cochin (RC14) and Regional Centre Vatakara (RC83).
